REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration will be done ONLINE and OFF CAMPUS, for which you may use a hand held device or computer facility at your disposal.

You will :

- Access the website, www.unizulu.ac.za
- Go to Student Zone and click on Registration 2024
- Click to Register
- Log in using your student number and user pin
- Follow all the Registration steps
- Print your Proof of Registration Student Admin Office can assist you with this.

In order to register online, returning students will need to have:

- Settled arrear fees
- Fulfilled the requirements for promotion to the next level of study in the relevant programme
- Submitted all outstanding documentation (ID, matric/senior certificate, proof of residence) for student files.

REGISTRATION DATES

Registration for senior students commences on ***

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU REGISTER DURING THIS PERIOD.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In terms of the Immigration Act, international students must provide:

- Valid passport and UNIZULU study permit
- SAQA verification certificate (Post-graduate students if one is not on your file)
- Letter proving adequate medical insurance cover,

Documents should be emailed to: cebekhulub@unizulu.ac.za **before** you will be able to register in 2024.

All international students will be blocked from registering until all required documents are in order.

WHO WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REGISTER ONLINE?

The following students will not be able to register online;

- Students with some form of exclusion due to a transgression
- Students whose finance has not been cleared i.e. fees are owed, financial plans not approved and implemented.
- International students who do not comply with the above

If, for any other reason, you encounter problems registering online, you will need to contact Student Administration or your Faculty to complete your registration. See support contact details on page 5.

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CELLPHONE NUMBERS

If you have changed your cellphone number please ensure that you have updated it on iEnabler. It is very important that your cell number is correct at all times on the system as the University will use this number to communicate with you. It is also very important that we have a next-of-kin contact number on the system. Please ensure that there is one for you.

FINANCE

Students not owing prior fees will be cleared for registration. Students owing fees may obtain Payment Plan forms by sending an email to paymentplans@unizulu.ac.za before the 2023 academic year ends so they can be cleared to register.

NSFAS AND BURSARIES

Students receiving NSFAS will be flagged for registration, after NSFAS has approved that they meet the criteria to be funded. Returning students must pass 55% of their modules in order to meet NSFAS criteria and be successful in obtaining funding for 2024.

The N+ Rule sets the limit for the duration that a student may receive financial aid from NSFAS for a programme (N+1 applies to all students and N+2 applies to students with disabilities).

Once a bursary has been confirmed with the funder, students with bursaries will be cleared for registration.

STUDENT HOUSING

Students that successfully made applications to be considered for space at the residences in 2024, will be placed at the residences after the release of the examination results and that will be prior to the start of registration. Students are reminded that placements at the residences depend on meeting all the qualifying requirements. After the placements, students will be required to register academically before they can register for residence. Students are advised to register their room right after completing their academic registration in 2024. Students who delay registering rooms allocated to them will forfeit them to other qualifying students without further notification. The capacity of residences at the University cannot, unfortunately, accommodate all of its qualifying students.

STUDENT CARDS

It is imperative that you get a student card once registered. 2024 student cards can be processed and collected from the Student Card Office on the Campus that you will be studying on. Proof of Registration and ID will need to be produced.

SUBMISSION OF MATRIC/SENIOR CERTIFICATES

Second and Third year students, if you matriculated in 2021 and 2022 respectively and have not yet submitted your matric/national senior certificate, please do so as soon as possible at the Student Card Office (opposite FAB offices), (KwaDlangezwa Campus Students) or at Office A2-13 (Richards Bay Campus Students).

OLD MINISTERIAL MODULE & PROGRAMME CODES

Students enrolled with old ministerial modules and programme codes (eg. ACOM141, CACC301, ELLG112, SMTH111) will still be able to continue with their studies in 2024.

STEP BY STEP GUIDE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION



Select "Registrations" on the left. Read the Registration Rules and click "l accept"



Select your "Employment Status" in the drop down list in this field. "Employment Status" Click "Save and Continue" If you are a Final Year Student click YES, if not click NO.



The screen will show the breakdown of your fees. Click "Accept Registration" to continue with the registration process

"Proof of Registration" will be displayed. Click "Print" should you have access to a printer OR print your Proof of Registration on Campus





Click "Qualification Code" Then Select "Register for this Qualification" Select your subjects, by ticking the box next to each subject. Ensure that you select all compulsory subjects. Select balance of modules from list of electives. Note that you may not register for modules where the prerequisite has not been met. These subjects will be indicated with a red dot.

Click "Save and Continue" if you are absolutely sure that you have selected the right module, offering type and period study.
